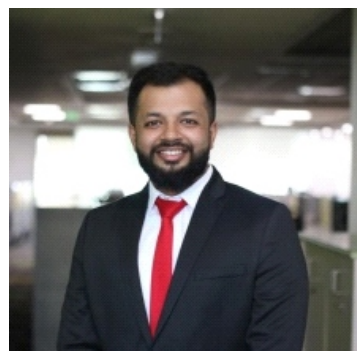


Editorial - Our Planet
